Original documents required at the time of joining /reporting in allotted Medical/Dental College are as mentioned below:

- i. Admit Card issued by NBE
- ii. Result/Rank Letter issued by NBE
- iii. Mark Sheets of MBBS/BDS 1st, 2nd & 3rd Professional Examinations.
- iv. MBBS/BDS Degree Certificate/Provisional Certificate.
- v. Internship Completion Certificate/Certificate from the Head of Institution or College that the candidate shall complete the Internship by 31st March, of the year of admission.
- vi. Permanent/provisional Registration Certificate issued by MCI or DCI/State Medical or Dental Counsel. Provision Registration Certificate is acceptable only in cases where candidate is undergoing internship and likely to complete the same on or before 31st March of year of admission.
- vii. High School/Higher Secondary Certificate/Birth Certificate as proof of date or birth.
- viii. Candidates allotted seat must carry one of the identification proofs (ID Proof) to the allotted college at the time of admission (as mentioned in the information Bulletin published by the National Board of Examinations (NBE) for AIPGMEE i.e. PAN Card, Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or Aadhar Card).
- ix. The Candidate should also bring the following certificates, if applicable
  - a) SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the format as specified in the prospectus) and should be in English or Hindi language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
  - b) OBC certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates should not
